Anyone with a learning disability or autism is welcome to attend the gardening sessions. The sessions are free to attend. We will carry out a short assessment of a persons care needs. If they need more individual support a carer is welcome to attend with them. We expect all our carers to join in with the activities as a gardening volunteer. Whilst a young person is guided by their carers and volunteers during the sessions they are encouraged to attempt to complete tasks for themselves giving them a sense of achievement.
