

Parent/Carer meetings on CAMHS experiences Meet the Commissioners

These meetings are an informal discussion to explore family experiences.

Parent representatives from the groups above will faciliate the meetings; accompanied by either one or both of the CCG Childrens Commissioners (from Kingston and Richmond).

We will collate the discussions, based upon the questions below, into a summary report co-authored by SEND Family Voices, Express CIC, NAS Richmond and ADHD Richmond.

The output may inform the structure for a full consultation on diagnostic pathways for autism and/or adhd in the future. These are the questions we will explore:

- **1.** Is a diagnosis important?
- 2. What worked well about the process? What didn't work well?
- 3. What are the benefits of diagnosis (if any)?
- 4. After diagnosis, what changed for your child? And what changed for you?
- 5. What services did you feel able to access whilst waiting for a diagnosis?
- 6. Who helped you? ... and what else could have helped and when?
