BOOST is a new one day a week provision based at Ham Youth Centre supporting young people experiencing emotionally related school avoidance (ERSA).

BOOST has a participative and learner-centred approach where young people have an input in the provision they receive. It is a nurturing, supportive environment and the programmes offered are closely linked to young people's needs, aspirations and interests and aim to build confidence and resilience.
