What we think we know...

- Parents and Young People tell us they are not aware of what's available locally and therefore do not feel they can navigate the system as easily.
- Transition pathways are not clearly articulated - Health, Social Care and Education
- Health pathways are not as well developed as they need to be.
- Schools and other providers tell 'us' they are not aware of what is available.
- Outcomes are not developed holistically, often with little focus on Preparing for Adulthood.
- Pathways are better understood when they are known to services, like Continuing Healthcare and Children with Disabilities Team/ LD Adults Social Care.

Pathway Planning

Activity:

- Questionnaire developed for YP and families to ask about transition to develop benchmark and inform practice
- Transition Framework: Collaboratively created with schools and Colleges.
- NDTI (National Development Team and Inclusion) Training sessions with SENDCo, Career Leads and LA officers to improve implementation of Careers, Advice and Guidance.
- Commissioners engaged to improve pathway planning, linked to sufficiency strategy
- Combining Access All Areas and Way to work event - 22nd September 2022

Data supporting Transition

Key progress, current challenges, focus for next 3 months and other developments:

- Updates on the Local Offer about timeliness/ expectations relating to Annual Reviews
- Created google forms to better manage data linked to transition/ careers advice - to support pathway planning.
- Annual review form re design with secondary SENDCo, PCF, RUILS, Young People: being piloted now!
- Training delivered to secondary SENDcos.

Preparing for Adulthood Outcomes

Updates: Key progress, current challenges, focus for next 3 months and other developments:

- NDTI engagement: Discussion and revisit of approach.
- Development of examples of holistic outcomes shared with secondary SENCo forum.
- Development of multi-agency holistic outcomes workshop.
- Pilot projects with Special schools under - summer term.
- Discussion around development of a holistic outcomes workshop with Parents/Carers - tbc
- Development of practice around external professional participation in annual reviews

Health and Social Care Pathways

Updates: Key progress, current challenges, focus for next 3 months and other developments:

- Therapies provision 16-18 for those in Kingston schools has been resolved
- Dynamic Support Register in discussion , delay in implementation related to development of a national template but operational agreement to participate in multi-agency discussion about young people at risk of hospitalisation/ placement breakdown.
- Clarity required about how therapy will be delivered for the 18- 25 cohort.
- Transition pathway for CYP in receipt of Continuing Healthcare shared, need to develop further to link to adult services.
- Work around reasonable adjustment in primary care underway with consideration of appropriacy of timing / communication channels to access GPs.
- Deep dive of data on annual health checks for people with LD and update shared to the Local Offer.
