Things to remember

Relationships between sibling are complex in any family.

Relationships with siblings are life long and can change at different stages

Both children can learn from even difficult experiences

Siblings of children with special needs are often empathic, resilient, independent and have a unique view on the world

What are the common challenges?

Limited time and attention from parents

Confusion/anxiety about their sibling's disability

Worry about friends' reactions

Worry about upsetting parents if express negative feelings about sibling

Lack of sleep!

Top Tips

Be Kind to yourself- You have a lot on your plate.

Take a step back to look at the familyhow do you communicate/interact/have fun etc

Let siblings express themselves -even if what they are saying is difficult to hear.

Don't need to always do things together. Both children need to develop their own interests and identity

Top Tips

Age appropriate information about their sibling's condition can help-talking, books, tv, meeting other siblings.

What do they <u>really</u> want from you. Might be different from what you think they want. Is there a way to make it happen?

Talk to school or nursery to make them aware of their challenges as a sibling
