SEND Hackathon

Also, we met with the Deputy Head of Youth Services to discuss the type of youth provision for all young people with SEND.



Let's Talk SEND Year 9

The Tower Hamlets SEND department and Tower Hamlets and City SENDIASS hosted a Let's Talk SEND Year 9 event on a Saturday in December at the Brady Centre.

Parents, carers, and young people with SEND came to meet senior leaders in Tower Hamlets and to hear from different professionals and services about the future possible options for young people with EHC plans.

Our Time came along to talk to young people and their parents about opportunities for young people to get their voice heard.

Every Chance for Every Child Forum - Bullying and Mental Health

Every Chance for Every Child is the name of the Tower Hamlets Children and Families Strategy 2019 – 2024. This is a plan to help improve lives for children and families.

This forum is a chance for different leaders, professionals and community representatives to see how well the plan is going.

Members from Our Time did a presentation about what are some of the issues young people with SEND face when it comes to bullying and ideas for how this can be improved.

What did we do in the Winter/Spring Term?



We hold Our Time Forum meetings on a regular basis. This includes meetings being SEND Superheroes at Spotlight, the Young People's Advice Centre and weekend pizza days as we always do!

We participated in different types of activities such as bowling, board games, drawing and having discussions with each other.

Our Time monthly sessions at Spotlight

We run sessions at Spotlight once a month as we are working on reaching out to young people with SEND across Tower Hamlets.

Our Time at Haileybury Youth Centre

Haileybury Youth Centre is a new youth provision that was launched on 9th January 2024 providing weekly evening sessions for those aged 11-25 with mild to moderate SEND.


Our Time attends every session to support the staff and young people who participates in the youth club.

Youth Voice Matters Conference in Birmingham



We attended The Youth Voice Matters Conference to represent young people with SEND from Tower Hamlets. This opportunity enables young people to develop their participation skills, give an opportunity for young people to speak up and to recognise the impact that they can have when taking part in local and national decision-making about Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities (SEND).

Our Time had a wonderful time while we stayed over a night in Birmingham for the Youth Voice Matters Conference.

Our Time members, Luca, Shahid and Sornnaly went to some workshops about accessibility within communities and a second workshop based on transitions to secondary schools and colleges.



Annual SEND Summit and the SEND Alternative Provision Improvement Plan

Sornnaly Hossain, Chair of Our Time and other Our Time Forum members attended the London Innovation and Improvement Alliance (LIIA) Annual SEND Summit at City Guildhall in March.

The summit was for SEND managers and directors in London to hear from the Department for Education on how some possible changes to the SEND system will be implemented.

Before the presentation, members of Our Time looked at the government's SEND and Alternative Provision Improvement Plan. We talked about what we thought, what we liked and our concerns.

Sornnaly delivered a presentation to over 100 senior managers, which was praised for its honest appraisal of the plan.

International Women's Day

Sornnaly attended the International Women's Day event at the Tower Hamlets Town Hall to celebrate the achievements of women, as well as represent the Our Time Forum and the Youth Council. Sornnaly highlighted the importance of inclusion, participation and encouragement for people with SEND. Ways on how to get help and support was also mentioned in her speech.

SEND Improvement Board

The SEND Improvement Board is a group of leaders in Tower Hamlets and community representatives who work together to improve life for people with SEND and their families.

At the Board, Our Time shared updates about the work we did in the last year (April 2022 – April 2023) and our views about how things are for young people with SEND in Tower Hamlets.

Sornnaly and Yaomin represent Our Time at SIB meetings to get young people's voices heard.

Making films

We have written outlines, storyboards, and script for three films we have been funded to make. We came up with three ideas for films.

- All about Our Time.
- Advice to parents to help young people be independent.
 What it's like to have SEND.

We have contacted film making organisations to see if they can help us and hope to film in the autumn.

Being part of National Council for Disabled Children

We are working closely with National Council for Disabled Children to share the views of young people with SEND from Tower Hamlets to make developments to the SEND support system nationally.

What do we want to do in the summer term?

We have started a project with FLARE (Department for Education's national young SEND advisory group) where we share our views about SEND topics for the Department for Education. At our first session, we talked about mediation. We will have 4 more sessions about different topics.

We are going to work with an organisation who can help us make the films we have planned.
