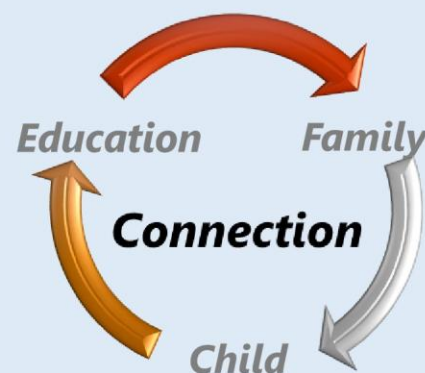




Workshops for Parents and Carers of Primary-aged Children with Communication and Interaction Differences

1	Introduction to Autism	This session will explore the way children and young people communicate, interact, and build relationships. It will also offer practical strategies to support communication at home and in everyday situations.	Monday 1 st June 2026	12pm to 2pm
2	Safety Awareness	Focusing on personal safety, this session will cover strategies to support children and young people in understanding boundaries, recognising danger and developing independence while staying safe at home and in the community.	Monday 8 th June 2026	12pm to 2pm
3	Communication	This workshop will focus on the different ways children and young people communicate, including non-speaking communication, and how we can support their understanding and communication. It will include practical ideas and resources that can be used in daily routines.	Monday 15 th June 2026	10am to 12pm (Please note change of time)
4	Speech and Language	Hosted by a specialist speech and language therapist, this session will look at how speech and language develops, common challenges, and when to seek further support. It will also offer tips and tools to support speech and language at home.	Monday 22 nd June 2026	12pm to 2pm
5	Emotional Regulation	This workshop will look at how children and young people experience and express a range of emotions, and how this can affect their behaviour and wellbeing. We will explore ways to help children and young people recognise and share their feelings - whatever they may be - in a safe and supportive way. The session will include practical tools to help children and young people express their emotions and develop healthy ways to manage them.	Monday 29 th June 2026	12pm to 2pm
6	Toileting	Our Toileting workshop is for parents/carers who wish to support their child/young person towards confident, and independent toileting. For some children, particularly those with communication and interaction differences toileting can feel overwhelming. This session offers practical strategies and visual support approaches to reduce anxiety and build success step by step.	Monday 6 th July 2026	12pm to 2pm
