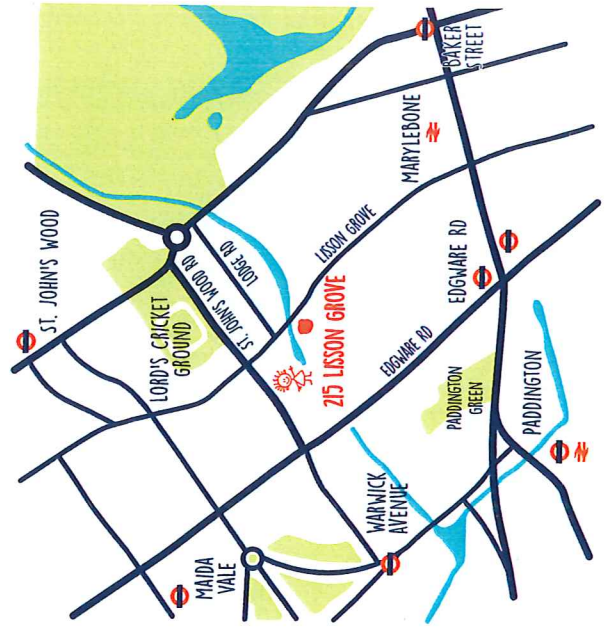
# HOW WE CAN HELP YOU

We offer a range of support for children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) including:

- advice about getting extra support from your school or college
- information and advice about statements and education health care plans (EHC)
- help and support around requesting an assessment or converting statements to an EHC plan
- identifying suitable schools or colleges
- help and support with appeals to the SEND tribunal
- training on SEND law and guidance
- information about other organisations that might be helpful
- referrals to Independent Supporters to act on behalf of you or your child and provide additional support suited to your own particular needs
- SEND school exclusions
- SEND transport and assistance.
