0-25 Disability Service Timeline

July 2017 Disabled Children's Team and Transitions Team merged to form new 0-25 Disability Service

Oct 2017 Head of Service Sarah Lowe joined Barnet

Feb 2018 Team Manager Graeme Baylis joined Barnet

New Disability Resource Panel formed

April 2018 All children's cases reviewed

May 2018 Geraldine Meade and Tokunbo Agunbiade became the Deputy Team Managers



What is the 0-25 Disability Service

- Specialist service for children and adults 0-25 who have profound and severe disabilities and/or complex health needs.
- Plus for young people 18-25 who have a diagnosed learning or physical disability
- We provide support and advice to other social care teams who are responding to the needs of disabled children who do not meet our criteria



Who uses our Service?

- 190 Children under 18 are allocated to a social worker
- Another 78 Children under 18 have Care and Support packages and are reviewed annually
- 200 Young People 18-25 are currently open (In July 17 this was 72)
- There are high numbers of young people turning 18 in the coming year







Every child and young person who we provide a service to deserves to have the correct plan of how their lives are going to change for the better



Service Improvement Update

- We have reviewed our operations, listened to our families and partners and developed an Improvement Plan
- We are working hard to ensure the correct plan is in place for all children and young people
- The team are motivated and determined
- Our management team is stable
- Our social workers are very knowledgeable and experienced in disability
- Our team is culturally diverse



Service Improvement Update (cont...)

- We are developing positive partnership working
- We have significantly improved our response to safeguarding concerns
- We have developed a process which reduces delay in requesting support
- We have started to attend to Parent Drop-Ins
- We are a creative team who want to develop a really positive and responsive service



But there is more work to do...

- Continue to simplify processes
- Improve how we listen to the voice of the child or young person
- Ensuring every child's plan is reviewed
- Continue to improve our transition planning
- Re-ignite our links with Barnet Parents Carers Association
- Address the issues with Direct Payments
- Further develop our links with Education and Health
- Provide support and advice to those who do not meet our eligibility criteria
- Continue to progress our Improvement Plan
- Improve our Short Breaks Provision



Children with Disability (CWD) Pathways

Pathway	Process	Support & Annual Review	Safeguarding
CWD 1	CWD Assessment to work out support needed and CWD plan formulated.	√	
CWD 2	CWD Assessment as above but child's case is allocated to worker	✓	
CWD 3	Child and Family Assessment and child likely to have a CIN or CP Plan to support the family. The child may also become Looked After	Ongoing

- Occupational Therapists (0-18) moving to Integrated Therapies






Parents have asked

Why have there been so many staff changes?

Over 50% of our team have been in a Barnet Disability
Team for between 1 and 12 years

The Head of Service is now permanent and in fact 80% of our leadership team is now permanent





Parents have asked

Do social workers really understand our experience?

70 % of our social workers have worked as personal carers

87% of our Team have had experience of caring for a family member who has a disability
