

CCG Statutory Duties

- Identify and inform the Local Authority and parents of children under compulsory school age with possible special educational needs
- Ensure arrangements are in place to jointly consider, agree and secure the health provision that is reasonably required
- Integrate health with SEN provision and social care provision where it will promote well being and improve quality
- Must jointly commission services wherever possible and consider how best to integrate the commissioning of services for children and young people with SEN
- Develop effective ways of harnessing the views of their local communities so that commissioning decisions on services for those with SEN are shaped by people's experiences and aspirations
- Ensure that information is available through the local offer



Four years on....
