- All children will be assessed using our <u>Barnet SCERTS assessments</u>
- On-going <u>Early Support</u> and signposting to other services.
- BEAM Target Plan (using SCERTS model)
- BEAM Target review meetings
- <u>Nursery support</u>: Minimum of half termly visits to the nursery to support with strategies and setting/reviewing targets.
- Report to support application for EHCP.
