Introduction

Welcome to Children's Integrated Therapies in Barnet available for children and young people from 0 – 19 years and up to 25 years for those with Special Educational Needs or Disabilities.

The service provides a single point of access to:

- service users
 - professionals
 - referrers for Children and Young People's Speech & Language Therapy including Dysphagia and Complex Needs, Health & Social Care, Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy.
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Referral

Although the service is based in Edgware Hospital, clinicians will offer care to children living in the borough of Barnet in their homes, children's centres, schools and clinics across the borough.

You can expect to receive a variety of services including:

- group support
- individual advice
- and specialist advice as well as support

from children's centre staff and schools where directed by therapists.

Multi-disciplinary planning

If you or your child is referred to the service, the referral will be reviewed by the integrated therapies team and the borough wide intake team to ensure multi-disciplinary planning for the best care and outcomes.
