

Holiday Childcare Scheme

The Tower Hamlets Holiday Childcare Scheme provides childcare for children aged 3 to 13 years old. The holiday provision takes place in Tower Hamlets schools and operates during 9 weeks of the school holidays (excluding the Christmas break), from an option between 8am to 6pm (for working parents) or 9am to 5pm.

The scheme provide a wide range of fun activities following the children's interests, including, sports, cooking, creative arts and crafts, street dance, Zumba, games, film making and much more.

The Inclusion service offers a limited number of funded places on the scheme for eligible children between the ages of 5-13 years old.




