Parents/carers and residents in general in Kingston and Richmond boroughs	Online survey	All SEND proposals in Kingston and Richmond	In March 2018, parents and carers were given four weeks to respond to the proposals, during which time two public meetings, hosted by SEND Family Voices (see above), took place. 74% of the 42 respondents either 'strongly agreed' or 'agreed' with the proposals; 16% either 'strongly disagreed' or 'disagreed' with them; and 10% 'neither agreed nor disagreed'.
