# With the right support and opportunities, many people with a learning disability can work.

Mencap's Interns And Outcomes programme offers a huge step towards making this happen – and it's available locally in Barnet.

## Who is the programme for?

This is open to people with a learning disability aged 16-24 with an Education, Health and Care (EHC) plan, who also:

- would like to find a job
- will be ready for work after completing the programme
- live in the London borough of Barnet
- will be able to travel independently by the end of the programme (Mencap can provide travel training to help with this).

## How does it work?

Interns And Outcomes is a full-time study programme lasting 12 months, including a work experience placement – usually about 6 months. The programme also provides a job coach to help interns learn on the job, plus group work opportunities to learn from one another and develop social skills.

## How does it help?

Interns And Outcomes offers a range of benefits, helping people with a learning disability to:

- build greater confidence
- improve English and maths skills
- better understand employment
- show employers what they can do
- progress towards paid work.
