The Primary Support Service offers consultancy on behaviour management and behaviour improvement to schools. The solutions we provide are tailored to each individual child and our packages of support are based upon the highly successful model that we use supporting schools across our two boroughs.

Most of the services below are offered free of charge to all maintained schools. Academies, free schools and other schools are welcome to refer and pay on a case by case basis. Support and consultation starts from $\mathfrak{L}100$ an hour.

- CME tuition commissioned by SEN for children without a school place. Referred by SEN
