





## **BEAM Service Delivery Overview 2019/2020**

#### **BEAM CRITERA:**

1. Pre-school age 2. Diagnosis of Autism 3. Not attending a Barnet specialist nursery 4. Residing in Barnet

# New to BEAM

OR

### **Starter Package**

- BEAM Initial Visit to home
   BEAM facilitator and manager visit to home.
   Gather information.
- Two x 1 hour sessions per week for a total of 16 sessions (approx. 8 weeks).
   Sessions are delivered in the home,
- Nursery visit/s in order to support staff.
- Access to the Autism Preschool Parent/Carer Programme 8 weeks and runs 5 times per year.

### <u>Transition to School Package</u>

- Package of home visit support including a block of weekly 1 hour home visits across the Summer term including support in organising a transition meeting with school/nursery.
- Access to the Autism Preschool Parent/Carer Programme 8 weeks and runs 5 times per year.
- Invitation to a 'Starting School' parent/carer group (usually held in July).

(This package is offered to families during the Summer term before their child starts school).

# Continuing with BEAM

### Weekly package \*\*

- 1 x weekly home visit
- Half termly nursery visits
- Access to Autism Preschool Parent/Carer Programme.

### **Consolidation Package\*\***

- 1 x monthly consolidation home visit
- Access to Autism Preschool Parent/Carer
   Programme

\*\*Package reviewed termly and allocated in accordance with BEAM service delivery criteria.

#### **Additional ongoing BEAM support**

OR

- All children will be assessed using our Barnet SCERTS assessments (based on SCERTS frame work 2006)
- On-going Early Support and signposting to other services based on the needs of the family.
- BEAM Target Plan (using SCERTS framework)
- Termly review of targets.
- Making referrals and working with NHS health professionals especially Speech and Language and Occupational Therapy.
- Nursery support with implementing support/strategies and setting/reviewing targets.
- Supporting applications for EHCP and SENIF.
- Support with choosing a school.
- Support with referrals to the NHS Occupational Therapy services
- Attendance at appointments e.g. with paediatrician(if requested and deemed useful)
- Close liaison with Social Care , Health and teams within Education and Skills dept,
- Any other support needed by families upon request e.g. housing letter.
