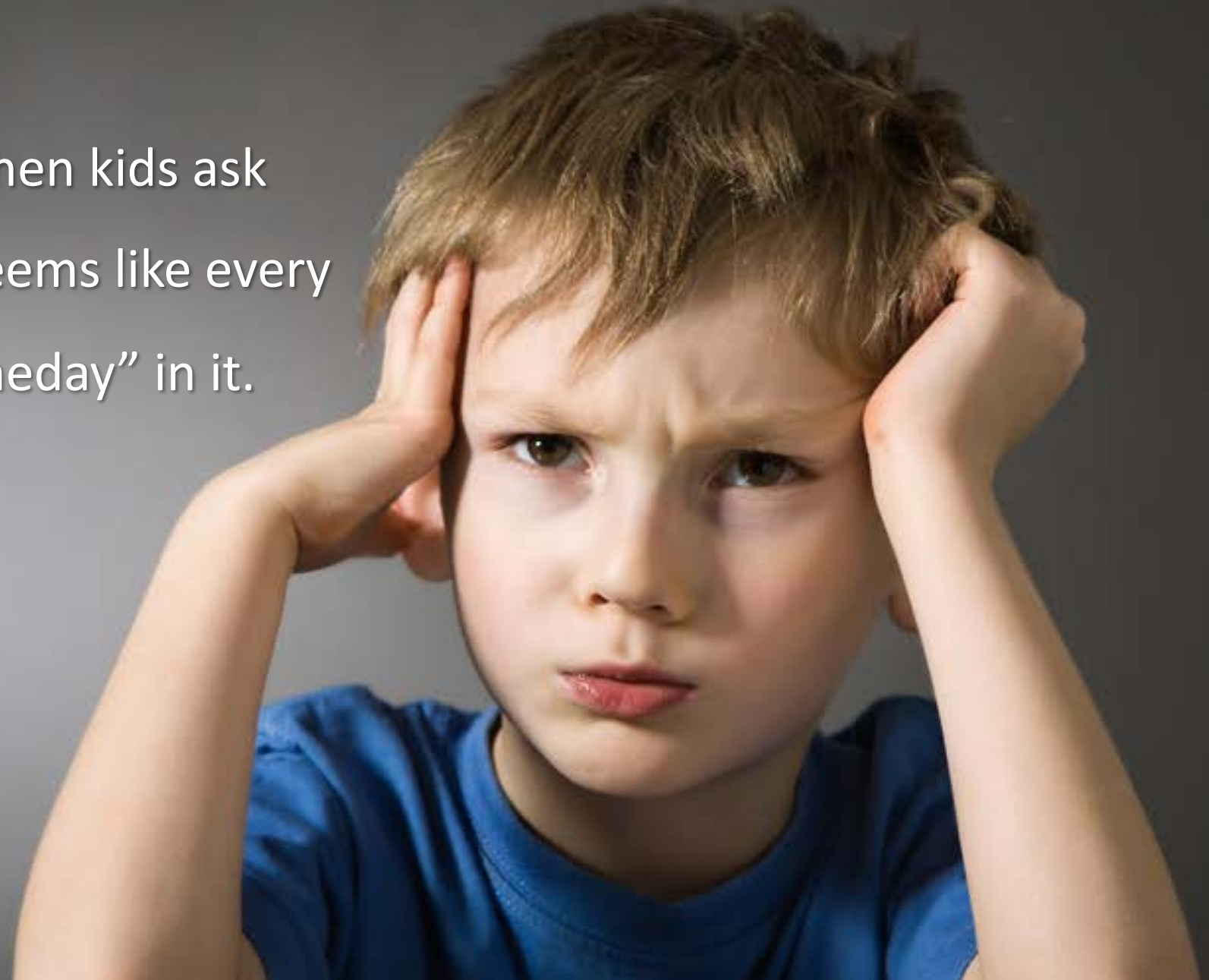


Someday:

like...





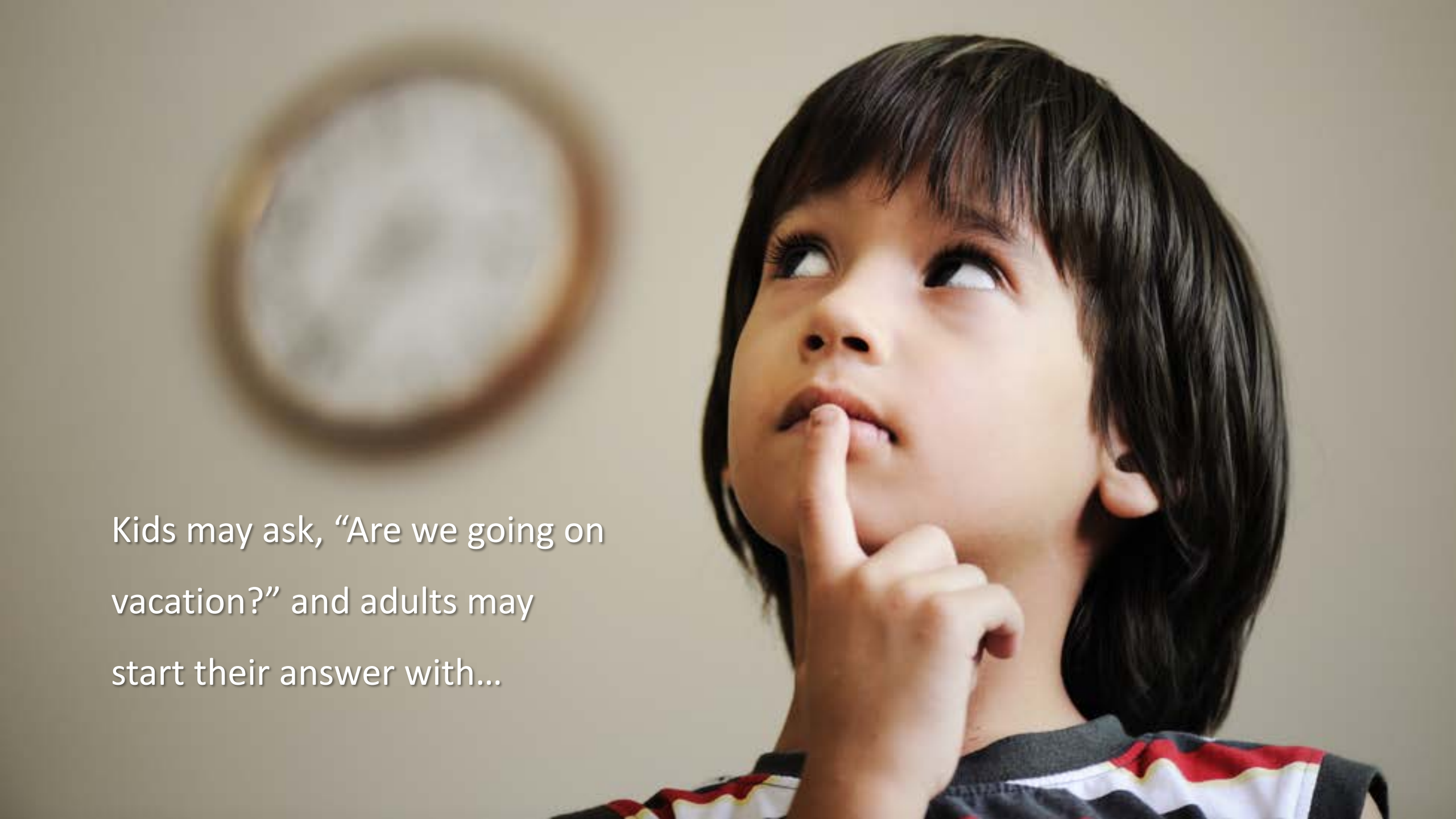
“Someday.”
