The Inclusion Advisory Team have received over the last few weeks a variety of SEND related COVID 19 questions. There has also been a considerable amount of information given by the government and different parties. The purpose of this document is to draw some the SEND related questions/information together in one place. However please do beware that this is an ever changing situation and answers may change according to the latest government guidance. The information here is intended to help you. You will always need to refer to your own **school's** guidance and policies.

Do I have to do Annual Reviews?

The DFE issued advice about annual reviews and the removal of statutory time frames. https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/changes-to-the-law-on-education-health-and-care-needs-assessments-and-plans-due-to-coronavirus/education-health-and-care-needs-assessments-and-plans-guidance-on-temporary-legislative-changes-relating-to-coronavirus-covid-19 Schools should aim to carry out annual reviews if they are due and seek the best advice from outside agencies that are available. Co-production with child and families should still be at the centre of the review. You may want to contact your families by email, telephone call All About Me Forms, chat to the young person, help them to complete. Do check the SENCo zone for further suggestions.





Should I still apply for EHCPs?

Schools should still apply for EHCP assessments. They should be very clear in the submission if Covid19 has affected the gathering of information or the ability to implement advice. Parent/carers can give permission via email.

Can we still apply for SENIF?

Schools should still apply for SENIF. If the child is at nursery or likely to be able to attend because of their circumstances. The application should go to Complex Needs Panel in the normal way. It must contain updated information about what the child needs.

Should we still be doing the Assess Plan Do Review Cycle?

Schools should still be making provision for children with EHCP. Schools should be making provision for children who are on the SEND Profile. Any support plan reviews should like annual reviews capture the voice of the young person and family where possible. Yes the Children's Intake Panel is still meeting virtually each week. Please continue to make referrals once you have parental permission.
