As an increased number of children and young people return to school following social isolation measures we anticipate an increase in the presentation of anxiety and mental health concerns.

For the most part this is a normal, expected reaction to a highly unusual and unsettling event, and will be most effectively managed through a nurturing whole-school approach in which social and emotional needs are prioritised – see the Bath and North East Somerset's guidance document 'Supporting Educational Settings During and After the Covid-19 Pandemic'.
