.You all have a different card with 9 different images.


.I am going to read a clue that links to one of the images.

.You have to look at your card and see if any of your images match the clue I have read out.


.If you think one of your images does, you must cross it out.


If you get 3 crosses in a row (up/down, across, diagonal) you must shout out "BINGO."
