



Secondary transition support for vulnerable pupils

Academic year groups 5 to 8

As part of a range of early intervention initiatives by Achieving for Children's Education Inclusion Support Service (EISS) we offer additional support to schools for those pupils they consider vulnerable at transition to secondary school.

A comprehensive programme, the 'Higher Needs Transition Programme' is available to schools to support transition in Year 6 and Year 7. This programme consists of 'off the shelf' lesson plans to support pupils with the move to secondary school, as well as direct work from the EISS with primary and secondary schools.

In addition, in 2019/20 we will be expanding this work to include:

- compilation of feedback regarding the success of the programme this academic year
 - rollout of process for all schools to advise EISS of vulnerable pupils
 - tracking of pupils deemed at risk on transition
 - offering additional advice and guidance to schools for those most at risk
 - supporting the link between primary and secondary schools on transition
