

# Education Inclusion Support Service

The Education Inclusion Support Service offers consultancy on all aspects of inclusion including behaviour management and whole school approaches, systems and policies.

The service supports schools in developing sustainable inclusion strategies and practices, as well as offering advice and guidance about children with SEN, including those with challenging behaviour and social and emotional difficulties which impact on behaviour for learning. The service can also support with effective multi-agency work around vulnerable children.

## Services or training offered

- Individual pupil consultation and advice
- Bespoke social emotional mental health (SEMH) group work coaching
- Pupils at risk of permanent exclusion, with SEMH and or SEN
- Reflective space coaching
- Training around emotional regulation
- One to one coaching and training on attachment
- Lunchtime supervisor training
- SENCO support and how and when to access AfC agencies
- SEMH/SEN best practice in the classroom
- Using ELSA strategies to offer support

## Example: Individual pupil package (22 hours) from £1,450

- Consultation
- Observation
- Planning of support and interventions
- Written diagnostic action plan
- Four teaching assistant coaching sessions (morning or afternoon)
- Support in tracking and analysing data
- Three monitoring sessions (via email and in person)
