I am safe, and my vulnerabilities are understood

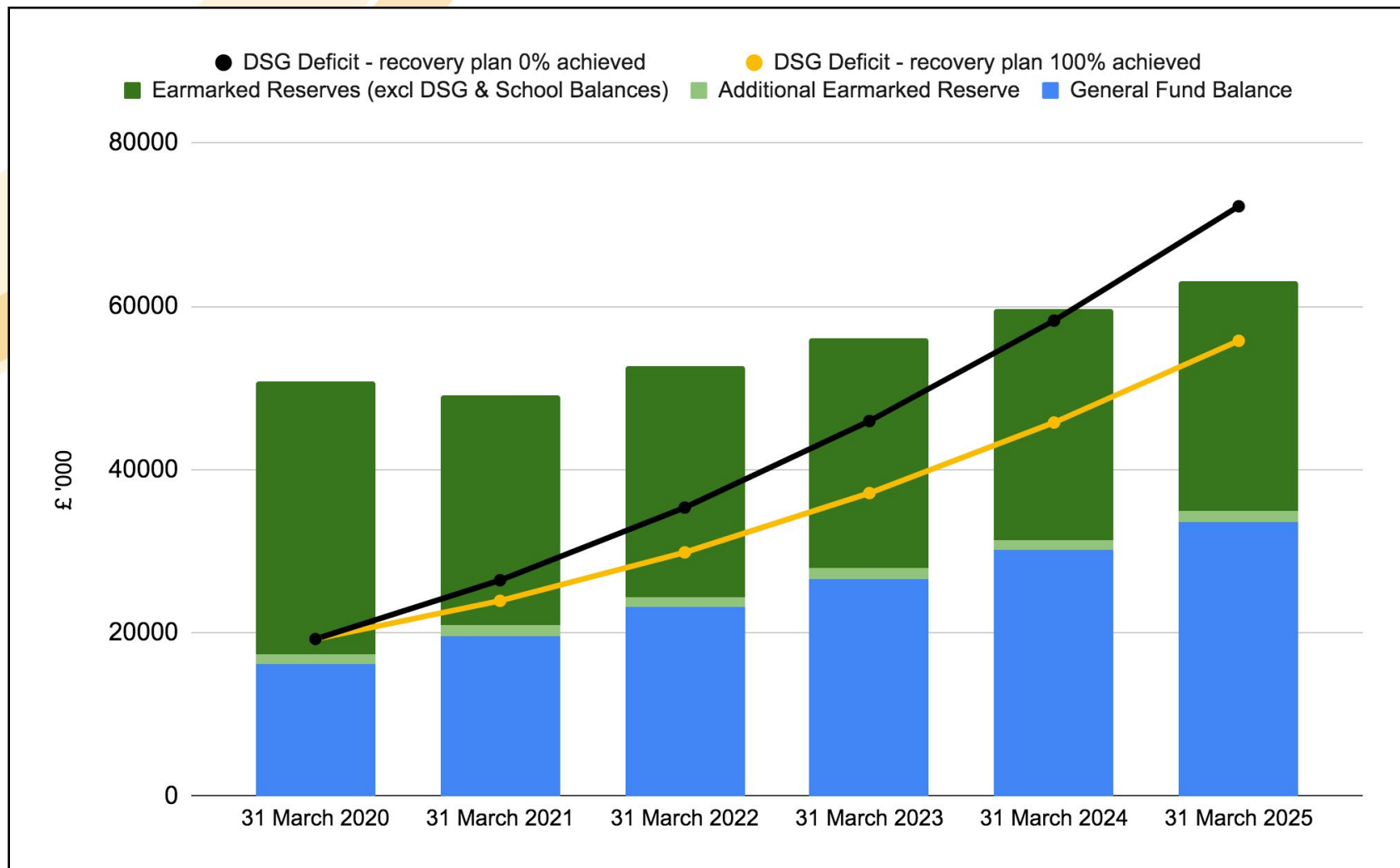
I am as healthy as I can be

I would like to be as independent as possible

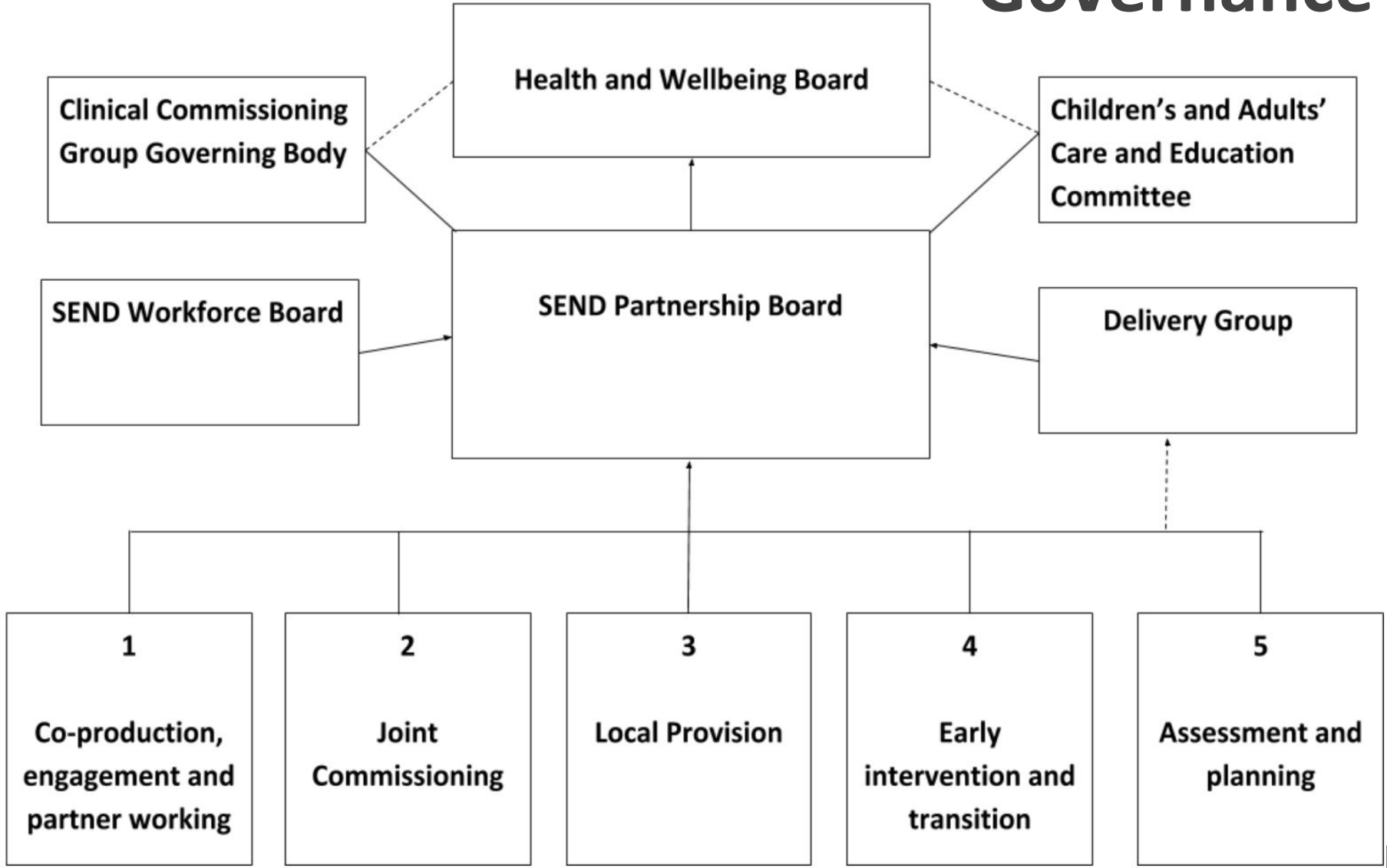
I am ambitious and achieve the best I can
