- Barnet Parent Carer Forum was set up in November 2014 by a group of parent carers in response to the change in legislation (Children & Families Act)
- All members are parent carers of children and young people aged 0-25 years.
- Funded by the Department for Education to engage with the Local Authority.
- We represent families' views and help to shape and improve services for our children and young people.
- Part of the National Network of Parent Carer Forums - national perspective





- Basic membership members receive regular email updates on events, training opportunities, surveys and other items of interest
- Steering group around 10 parent carers who jointly decide the priorities of the forum, attend workstream and other strategic meetings and work closely with the Local Authority
- Parents who sit on feedback groups independently.





- Stay informed about local SEND services and events
- Training opportunities eg writing a good EHCP, person centred planning, using the Local Offer
- Supportive environment with a group of like minded people
- Empowerment that comes with effective action
- A chance to make a difference to the services our children receive
