You will receive mentoring alongside group workshops to help you prepare for employment or training, supported by our team and MetroBank Kingston.

To be eligible for this programme, you need to be:

- **18 to 24, not in education, employment or training**
- **willing to commit to volunteering and work experience opportunities, via a social action programme led by young people working alongside Voices of Hope**
- **willing to commit to four weeks of part time workshops**
