At Kaleidoscope Sanctuary Hub you will be able to speak to a friendly support worker, who will give you a safe space to talk. We will listen, support, offer advice and empower your recovery journey.

Please note: Kaleidoscope Sanctuary Hub is not suitable for people needing urgent medical attention (for example, after selfharm) – for urgent medical care please attend your nearest A&E or call 999.
