Dear children, young people, parents and carers,

A letter to children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) in Kingston and their parents and carers

We hope that you are well.

We are writing to tell you about **Kingston's new Special Educational Needs and Disability Register**. We believe this may be of interest to you because a child or young person in your family is either registered as receiving additional support at school, or they have an education, health and care plan.

The register is a list of children and young people (under 25 years) who have special educational needs or a disability. The law says every local authority must have a register like this, but it is your choice whether you add your name to it.

The register will help us to understand who lives in the area and plan the support they need.

Here are some reasons you might want to add your name to the register:

- You will receive information about different topics, for example:
 - \circ $\,$ how you can be supported at school and college
 - the support available for parents or carers
 - activities and clubs for children and young people
- You will be invited to give your views about local services, including:
 - what is working well, and what you would like to continue
 - $\circ \;$ what is not working well, and what needs to be improved
 - your ideas for how to make services and support better
- You can choose to receive a **Disability Awareness Card**, which you can show as evidence of your additional needs or disability
