Autism specific group using Social Eyes as a framework	Social Eyes is a new and innovative approach to facilitating social skills and social understanding with people on the autism spectrum. Launched by The National Autistic Society in 2010, this learning resource has been developed with peo- ple with autism and Asperger syndrome, along with leading professionals in the field. All Social Eyes resources have been extensively piloted and re-piloted with ongoing development and re- search since 2005. Social Eyes does not ask people on the autism spectrum to change 'inappropriate' social behav- iour, or to acquire social skills by copying the 'typ- ical' behaviour of others. Instead, it gives people the option of learning social interaction skills or alternative social strategies. Social Eyes focuses on eight social skills that people on the autism spectrum can have difficulty with, including start- ing a conversation, eye contact and personal space. These session take place on a Wednesday evening from 6.00pm to 7.30pm.
