

## Autism Parent Carer programme Preschool/Early Years/Year 1

Teachers and therapists will deliver virtual sessions via ZOOM. It will include modules designed to increase your knowledge and skills with understanding and practical strategies to implement at home.

The programme also allows parents to share their ideas and knowledge with other parents and professionals.

The modules have been designed based on feedback from parents (collated over the past few years), updates in current research and good practice.

To access this programme you must meet the following criteria:

- Child has a diagnosis of Autism
- Child is not yet in nursery/ in nursery/in Reception/in year 1.
- Barnet resident
