Where could we be better?

sen plans followed

clear guidance for parents/carers when sen plans not followed

Therapy based on needs not "packages".

sen plans followed

More transparency within the process. Make informing parents/carers part of the process.

school accountability with sen support

Make sure that EHC plans are followed.

clarity on priorities

Transitions - Health, Care, education pathways
