BOOST is an alternative provision for Year 9 pupils that aims to enhance pupil self-esteem, confidence, resilience and engagement. There is a focus on students' aspirations and this programme will help them to understand the importance of education in achieving their chosen post-16 pathway. This work is delivered by highly skilled youth workers and there will be opportunities for students to gain AQA accreditation.
