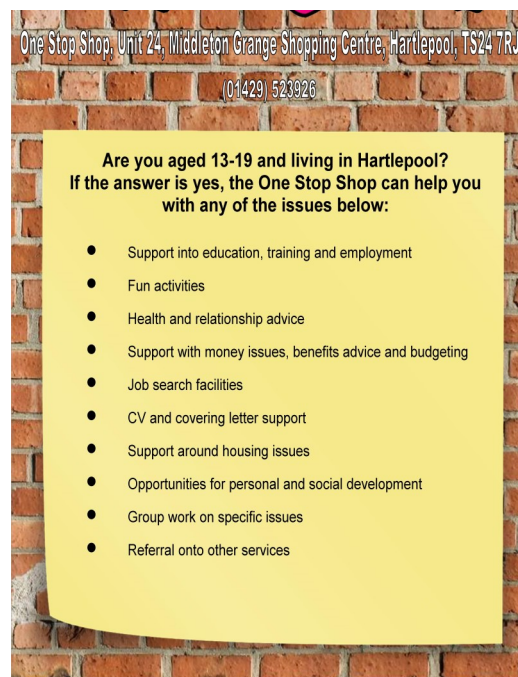
### Support in the run up to Christmas

## The Bread and Butter Thing

The Bread and Butter thing are a charity trying to help people and families get by. With the support of the Community Hub Central they are coming to Hartlepool.

They are able to offer weekly grocery shopping at a fraction of the high street price through their membership scheme and will always try to give a good balance of fruit and veg, something for your cupboards and fridge and we are constantly improving our supply.

The food provided comes from places such as supermarkets, factories and farms and is considered surplus to requirements by them for a variety of reasons. Usually this is due to overstocking. Supermarkets, for example, will try and guess what customers will want in advance and sometimes this doesn't go to plan.

The Bread and Butter Thing take what is available, meaning that some weeks may be better than others. However, you will always be saving money and getting new food to try.

### It's really easy to sign up to TBBT...

**Step 1** - Send us a text to **07537 416 040** along with your full name, postcode, and the name of the hub you will be collecting from (Community Hub Central).

**Step 2** - Select the size of order you want to receive. A typical family order would be £7.50, an individual would be £4. An extra-large family would be £15.

**Step 3** - We'll send you a text every Sunday to see if you want an order. All you have to do is reply "YES" to the text by 10:00AM Wednesday. We'll deliver your order to Community hub central, Thursdays at 12:00PM.

**Step 4** - Collect and pay for your goods from Community Hub Central.

**Send us a text to 07537416040 to get your first order free.**

A typical order will consist of 3 shopping bags. 1 of fridge items, 1 of cupboard items and 1 of fresh fruit and veg and costs £7.50. On weeks with less supply than normal you may not get 3 bags, but the price will be lower on these weeks.

<p>Hartlepool Youth Services offers a wide range of activities, advice and support from dedicated youth spaces from various locations across the town for young people aged 13-19 years (up to 25 years with Life Long Learning Disabilities).</p> <p><b>Switch It - music to transform young lives</b></p> <p>Switch It is a musical intervention for young people who are in need of extra support. Music leaders work alongside youth workers to help young people.</p> <p>Depending on the needs of the young people, the Switch It programme can offer young people both one to one support and group work activity.</p> <p><b>#TAGD (Tomorrow's A Good Day) - Emotional Wellbeing Group</b></p> <p>Youth workers working with young people have designed a 6 week programme to support young people manage their emotions. Topics include the importance of self-care, ways to wellbeing, mindfulness and relaxation techniques. Young people will also have the chance to relax with their peers and participate in youth centre activities.
