

Family Support service drop-ins Hartlepool



The Family Support service, delivered by Daisy Chain, facilitates weekly peer support drop-in sessions for Hartlepool families.

These sessions are for families of children who display characteristics associated with neurodevelopmental conditions including autism, sensory diversity, ADHD and Foetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD). This is for pre, post and during diagnosis - no diagnosis is needed to access support.

Peer support drop ins are relaxed and informal, providing you with the opportunity to meet other parents/carers in similar situations and discuss any topics or situations that you might be finding challenging, as well as sharing positive stories, top tips, strategies, and information. A member of the Family Support Team will always be present at these drop ins to provide support and facilitate the group.

Please note we cannot provide 1:1 support at the drop-ins, these are group sessions. The drop-ins are for parents/carers only-please contact the team to discuss if this will be a barrier to you attending.

These monthly sessions are for families of children who display characteristics associated with neurodevelopmental conditions including autism, sensory diversity, ADHD and Foetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD). This is for pre, post and during diagnosis - no diagnosis is needed to access support.

The purpose of the multi-agency drop ins are for parents to access information and guidance from several different services, all in one place. These agencies may include SENDIASS, Early Help, Family Hubs, Health Visitor or Parent Carer Forums. Please note this is general information regarding their service offer, criteria and how to access the service. Professionals cannot provide bespoke support specific to your child or family during these sessions but may be able to make an appointment for a later date if necessary. Please note these sessions are for parents/carers only-please contact the team to discuss if this will be a barrier to you attending.
